



Baloch Yakjehti Committee (BYC)

Press Release

The BYC has critically reviewed its structure and decided to form a new framework to organize a movement against the Baloch genocide, aiming to bridge different political parties and social forces with Baloch society.

The BYC has established a central organizing body, appointing Dr. Mahrang Baloch as the Central Organizer, Lala Wahab as Deputy Organizer, and Abid Hussain as the Karachi East Division President of the Baloch Yakjehti Committee. During the organizational formation, an interim constitution and manifesto were approved, alongside the establishment of a central working body.

Dr. Mahrang emphasized the importance of Baloch sympathizers joining the BYC and actively supporting its movement against the Baloch genocide.

She addressed the question regarding the issue of missing persons, stating that since returning from Islamabad, the problem persists unabated. Emphasizing the abduction of Baloch students, Dr. Mahrang reiterated that the BYC will continue to be their voice, as it has been in the past, and plans to hold protests as well.

Dr. Mahrang stated that the Missing Persons Committees have not played a significant role in bringing back the Baloch; instead, enforced disappearances are used as a tool to suppress the people. Institutions like the Counter Terrorism Department (CTD) in Balochistan operate above the law, with no institutions in the country to protect the Baloch. She further added that she would encourage a joint movement across Pakistan regarding the missing person's issue.
